## **SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES**

Work on the Project's final design and permitting was initiated. On July 23, 2015 FEMA provided comments to the proposed project described in the approved CLOMR. Subsequent meetings with FEMA on September 17 and October 7, 2015, and a conference call on November 17, 2015 were needed to determine the scope of work for the submittal. Documentation for the submittal is being developed and will be reviewed by the Independent Panel of Experts. Legal actions were taken by Atherton Cove Property Owners Association and Dominick Gulli with regard to the Project's CEQA documentation.

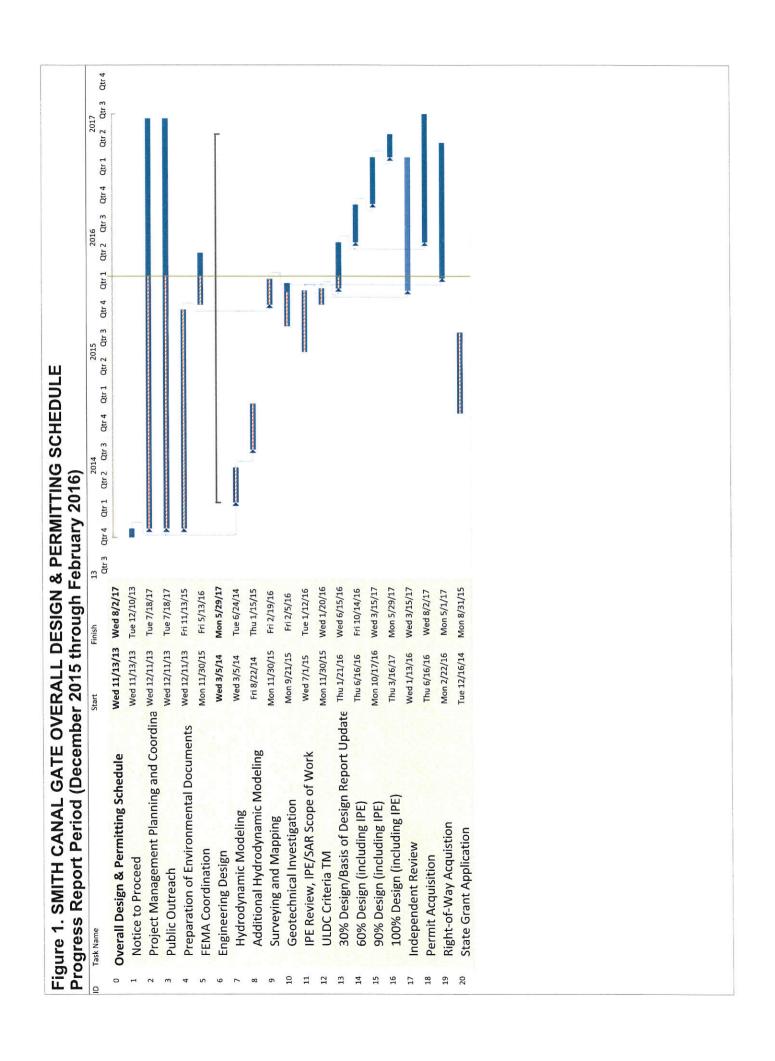
